Hello everyone,

This note is to help people get through the Wisconsin snowmobile trail pass process.

If you are a Wisconsin Snowmobile Club member, the trail passes are issued by the AWSC – Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs. These passes are issued for \$10.00, for each registered snowmobile.

We appreciate you joining the Sugar Camp Snowmobile Club. The AWSC raised its membership fee by \$2.00. We must adjust our fee to cover this increase. Once you are a member of any club in Wisconsin, you will receive an AWSC number. This number and a current membership enables you to apply for the \$10.00 passes. So, first you must join a club each year. It's good to start this process early, to avoid stress when the snow flies.

Once you have joined a club and the membership updates are keyed into the AWSC system. You then qualify for the discount passes. The easiest way to apply is to go to www.awsc.org . If you don't have your number, do a Membership Inquiry. And then just click on the WI TRAIL PASSES – Order Passes Online. The passes will be USPS mailed to your address. If your address is not correct, please let me or Debby know to correct it. You can print a receipt from the web page. All passes are mailed.

If you are NOT a member of a club, or you have not renewed for the current year you will not be able to get the discount passes. You can go to WI DNR Online sight or WI DNR sales agent.
